Here are some reasons why your pet may prefer a pet sitter over a kennel:

1. **Personal care and attention:** Pet sitters are there for your pet. They can devote attention to your pet at playtime and meal time and it is a one-on-one relationship that just can't be managed in a boarding kennel
 2. **They're in their own home environment:** Your pet will feel more at ease and comfortable with familiar sounds, smells and toys in their own home environment
 3. **No stress or illness:** For aged or anxious pets, transport to and from boarding facilities can create stress. They are also exposed to illnesses of other animals in the facility, so having a pet sitter come to them can reduce the stress and anxiety when you travel
 4. **Gaining a friend for life:** Many pet sitters develop strong relationships with the pets they care for, that pet owners often ask them back to pet sit again
